# Executive Summary

---

- ❑ 1609 Wage Scales were adopted in 724 hearings statewide in 2008 – 87 fewer scales than in 2007
  - ❑ Hearings were conducted in 83 of Indiana's 92 Counties.
  - ❑ The following counties adopted the highest number of scales:
    - Marion: 171 scales
    - Tippecanoe: 123 scales
    - Hamilton: 119 scales

# Executive Summary (Continued)

---

- The following counties had the highest number of separate hearings:
    - Marion: 72 hearings
    - Lake: 60 hearings
    - St. Joseph: 38 hearings
  
  - The following counties had the highest number of hearings on separate days:
    - Marion: 27 separate days
    - St. Joseph: 16 separate days
    - Hamilton: 14 separate days

# Executive Summary (AFL-CIO)

---

- ❑ The AFL-CIO Scale was presented for 1532 projects, and was adopted 1344 times  
(83.53% of total projects)
  - ❑ The AFL-CIO Scale was presented in 683 hearings, and was adopted 609 times (84.12% of total hearings)

# Executive Summary (ABC)

---

- ❑ The Associated Builders and Contractors (ABC) Scale was presented for 361 projects, and was adopted 200 times (12.43% of total projects)
  - ❑ The ABC Scale was presented in 126 hearings, and was adopted 81 times (11.19% of total hearings)

# Executive Summary (DWD & "OTHER")

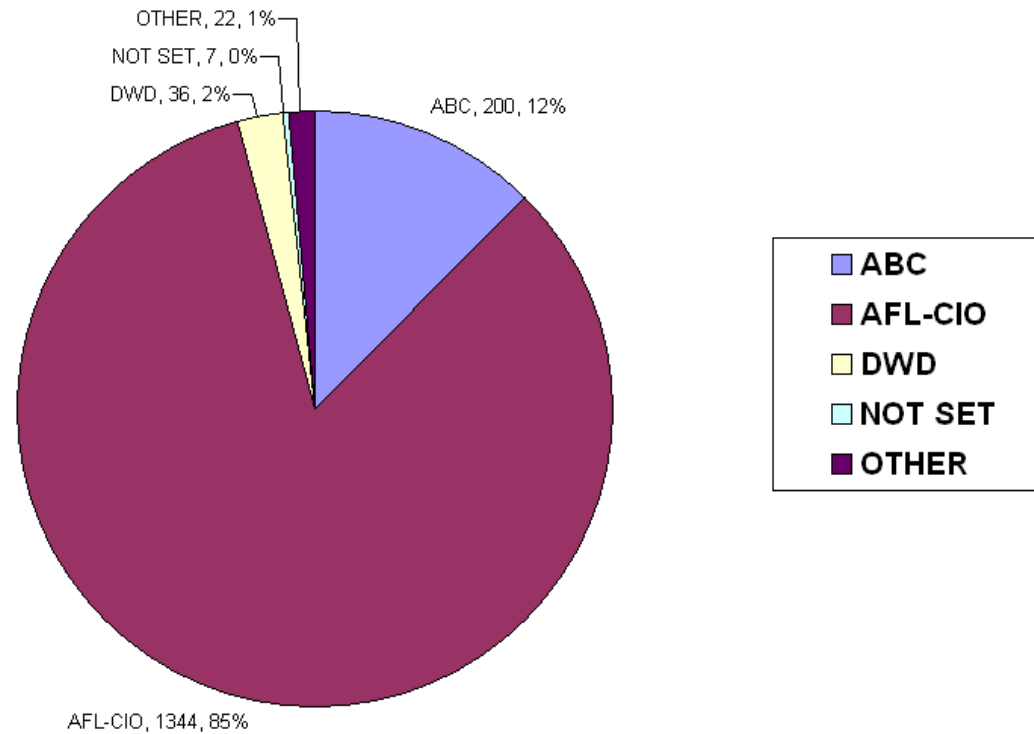

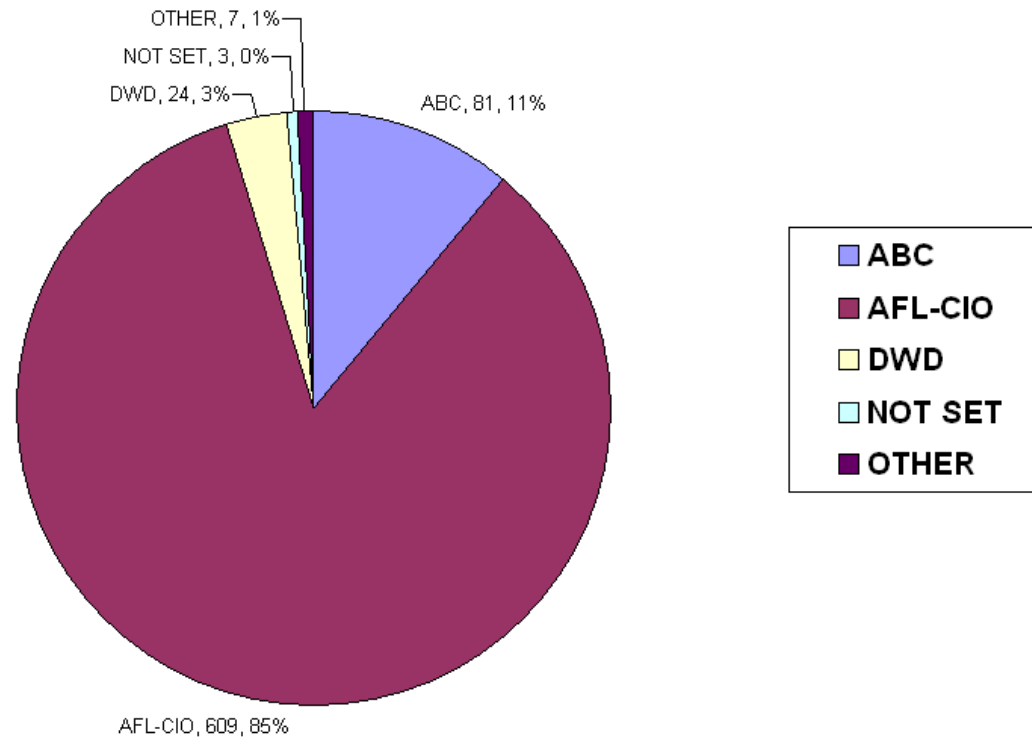
Scale Adoption Rates by Project
