## **OBJECTING PETITION IN OPPOSITION TO**

1. The 2008 Town of Jonesville Budget without effectively acting upon the following objections:

A. The decrease of Net Assessed Valuation from \$33,341,228.00 in 2007 to \$30,000,000.00 in 2008. This is an error that creates an "inflated" levy relative to property taxes and needs to be corrected to, at minimum, the 2007 level of Net Assessed Valuation.

B. The increase of 15% in the General Fund. The Town of Jonesville has lost industry, jobs and population since the last budget and an increase is neither warranted not justified. Furthermore, during the fiscal year 2007, the Town of Jonesville reappropriated and transferred \$86,000.00 from the General Fund to Cumulative Capital Improvements Fund to fund a non-budgeted rehabilitation/remodeling of the shelter in the Town of Jonesville park. The available revenues in the General Fund for this re-appropriation indicates that the 2007 budget for the General Fund was excessive and/or inflated. The excess revenues could have and should have been used to offset other actual and necessary operating expenses. The General Fund amount should be reduced from the 2007 level of \$456,510.00 proportionally to the loss of industry, jobs and population in the Town of Jonesville as well as the \$86,000.00 that was re-appropriated from it.

D. The increase of 41% in the Motor Vehicle Highway Fund. The Town of Jonesville has lost industry, jobs and population since the last budget and an increase is neither warranted not justified. Additionally, the Town of Jonesville recently purchase two (2) new police patrol cars, bringing their inventory of police patrol cars to a total of three (3) with the earliest model being only three (3) years old. The other motor vehicles in the Town of Jonesville inventory are of sufficient age and condition as to warrant a reduction in this account associated with motor vehicles to cover ongoing maintenance and repair only and NO replacement costs. The Motor Vehicle Highway Fund amount should be reduced from the 2007 level of \$61,700.00 proportionally to the loss of industry, jobs and population in the Town of Jonesville as well as any costs other than normal maintenance and repair of the motor vehicle inventory.
