CAMPAIGN FINANCE NOTICE

A candidate's committee must file its first campaign finance report no later than **NOON**, **Thursday**, **July 27**, **2010**, with the Indiana Election Division (if a candidate for a statewide or state legislative office) or with the appropriate county election board (if a candidate for a local office). A state legislative candidate must also file a copy of this report in the county where the candidate resides.

A candidate's committee must file a pre-election campaign finance report no later than **NOON**, **Friday**, **October 15**, **2010**, with the Indiana Election Division (if a candidate for a statewide or state legislative office) or with the appropriate county election board (if a candidate for a local office). A state legislative candidate must also file a copy of this report in the county where the candidate resides.

The candidate's committee must also file a pre-election supplemental report no later than forty-eight (48) hours after the committee receives any contribution of \$1,000 or more during the period beginning **October 9, 2010 and ending October 31, 2010**, with the Indiana Election Division, appropriate county election board, or both. If no such contribution is received, the candidate's committee is not required to file a supplemental report.

A person who fails to file a report with the Indiana Election Division or a county election board is subject to a civil penalty of \$50 for each day the report is late, with the afternoon of the final date for filing the report being calculated as the first day, for a maximum penalty of not more than \$1,000, plus any investigative costs incurred and documented by the Election Division or county election board.

SPECIAL CAMPAIGN FINANCE INSTRUCTIONS FOR WRITE-IN CANDIDATES FOR STATEWIDE OFFICE:

A candidate's committee must file "quarterly" campaign finance reports with the Indiana Election Division, according to the following schedule. These filings must be made electronically, and are subject to the same civil penalties set forth in the Campaign Finance Notice above. Contact the Campaign Finance Division of the Election Division for further information.

The committee must file quarterly reports no later than noon, Indianapolis time:

- (1) April 15, 2010, covering the period from January 1, 2010, through March 31, 2010.
- (2) July 15, 2010, covering the period from April 1, 2010, through June 30, 2010.
- (3) October 15, 2010, covering the period from July 1, 2010, through September 30, 2010.
- (4) October 26, 2010, covering the period from October 1, 2010, through October 18, 2010.
- (5) January 19, 2011, covering the period from October 19, 2010, through December 31, 2010.

The candidate's committee must also file supplemental reports with the Indiana Election Division no later than forty-eight (48) hours after the committee receives contributions from a person that total \$1,000 or more during the reporting periods listed below. If no such contribution is received, the candidate's committee is not required to file a supplemental report.

- (1) Supplemental Reporting Period: April 1, 2010, through April 15, 2010.
- (2) Supplemental Reporting Period: July 1, 2010, through July 15, 2010.
- (3) Supplemental Reporting Period: October 1, 2010, through October 15, 2010.
- (4) Supplemental Reporting Period: October 19, 2010, through October 26, 2010.
